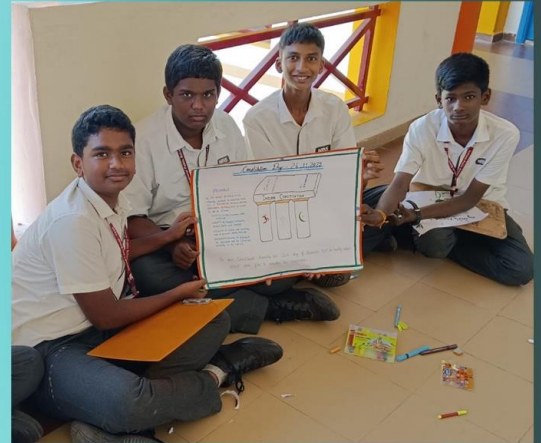
# தேசிய பசுமைப்படை பனை விதை விதைக்கும் விழா

# CONSTITUTION DAY

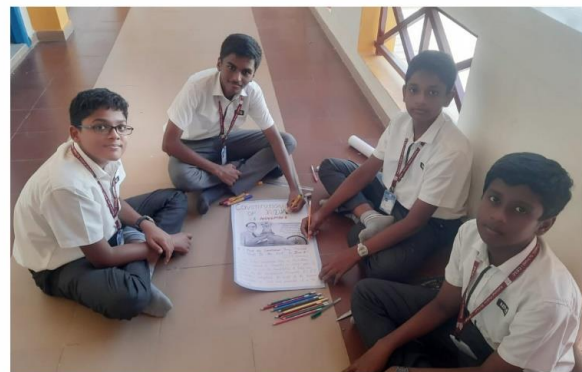
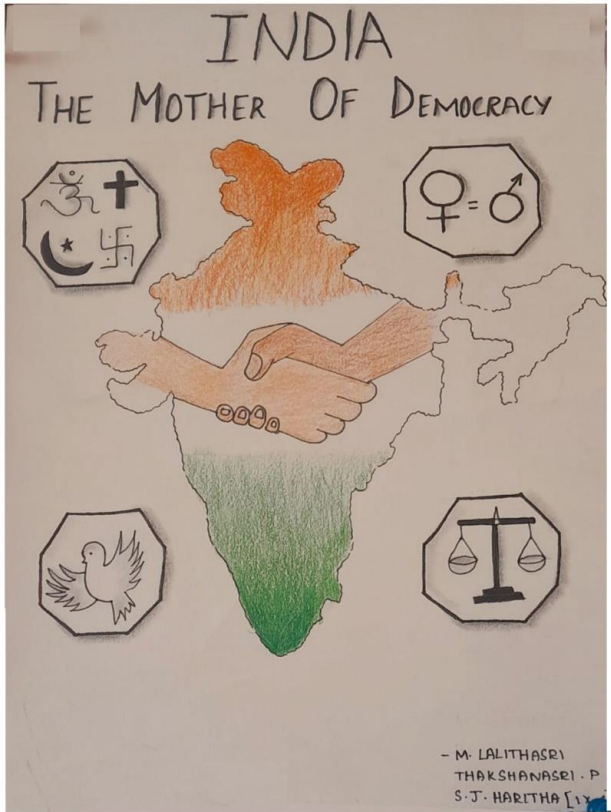
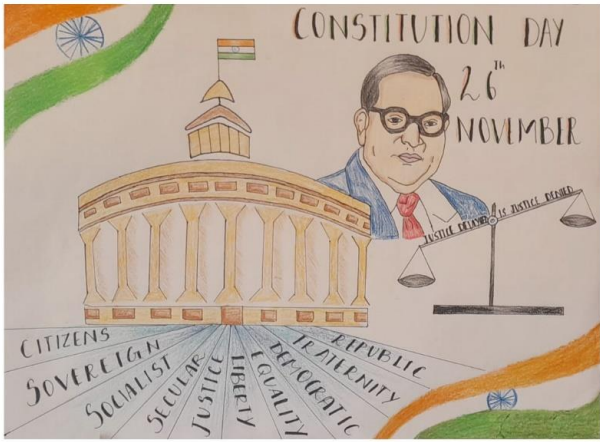

- To identify successful students at the State and National levels and felicitate them

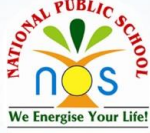
